Acts 3:1-11 WEEK 9

Life Group Curriculum

SHARE AN EXPERIENCE:

Share with the group about the most miraculous thing you've ever seen or have happen in your life.

GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

Last week talked about the Ideal Church, the ACTS 2:42-47 Church that Radiant strives to be. This week we start Chapter 3 and the discussion on miracles! What are they really? Is it really from God? Are miracles for today? How do we get one? Let's dig deeper.

Answer as many questions as time allows:

1. Take a moment to share with the group what stood out to you most from this week's message.
2. Read Acts 3:1-11. What is at the beginning of most miracles, how do they start? By what means can we cultivate deep intimacy with the Holy Spirit? Peter and John had awareness of the Spirit's voice, so they knew what the Holy Spirit desired to do. What did Peter and John do continually that enabled this awareness? How can we apply these principles to our lives today?
3. When was the last time you asked to be used by God? Ask yourself; Am I listening, looking, being obedient and bold enough to step out in faith? Read James 4:17, Think about what James is telling us here. Do you take action when you know you should? Why is this important? God desires our action in response to what He is doing. Read Acts 1:8. What does God expect us to do with this power?

SUPPORTING SCRIPTURE:

Acts 3:1-11, 1:8, 5:12; Romans 8:26; Psalm 55:17; John 9:8

MEMORY VERSE:

Isaiah 35:6 – “Then the lame leap like a deer, and the mute tongue shout for joy. Water will gush forth in the wilderness and streams in the desert.”

FOR PERSONAL DEVOTIONAL (OPTIONAL):

1. Join us in prayer this week for more of you, and that we allow you to do your work and we stay out of the way of your promises. We pray for your will to be done, and that needs are met and that your Glory is on full display in the miracles you perform every day. Thank you for the glimpses of Heaven you allow us to have daily in your presence. Allow us to go boldly this week, and share your truths so that all will have a opportunity to accept the joy only you provide.
